WHEREAS: Upon the recommendation of His Honor the Mayor and in the opinion of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Newton, public necessity and convenience require that three certain parcels of real estate be taken in fee, with all trees thereon and with all rights, title and interest to and over the bed of the Charles River adjacent to all said parcels but subject to the MDC easement recorded in the Middlesex South District Deeds at Book 9146, Page 003. The acquisition of all said parcels is for the municipal purposes of park and recreation uses; and

WHEREAS: One parcel is shown as Lot 2 on a plan incorporated herein entitled "CITY OF NEWTON, MASSACHUSETTS, NAHANTON STREET, LAND TAKEN FOR PARK AND RECREATION USE", and dated March 17, 1980 and recorded herewith. Said Lot 2 contains 1,374,763 square feet of land and is more particularly described as follows:

by said land of the City of Newton to the shore line of the Charles River; thence running in a southeasterly direction by said shore line of the Charles River to a point on the northwesterly line of Nahanton Street; thence N 73-15'-59" E, 225 fact more or less to the southwesterly tangent point of a curve of 1039.62 feet radius; thence by said curve to the right of 1039.62 feet radius; 823.27 feet; thence by said curve to the left of 980.04 feet radius, 349.13 feet to the point of beginning, the last three described lines being by said northwesterly, northerly and northeasterly line of Nahanton Street.

WHEREAS: The other two parcels are shown and described as

Lots A and C on a plan incorporated herewith entitled "CITY OF NEWTON,

MASSACHUSETTS, WILLIAMS STREET, LAND TAKEN FOR PARK AND RECREATION

USE", dated March 17, 1980 and recorded herewith. Lot A contains

approximately 30,330 square feet and Lot C contains approximately

31,851 square feet. Said Lots A and C are more particularly

described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northwesterly line of Williams Street distant 240.43 feet southwesterly from the intersection of the southwesterly line of Butts Street with said northwesterly line of Williams Street; thence S 14°-46'-52" W, 21.56 feet to the northwesterly line of a permanent surface easement along the Charles River taken by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on January 14, 1958; thence by an extension of said northwesterly line of Williams Street 20 feet more or less to the shore line of the Charles River; thence by said shore line of the Charles River in a southwesterly direction to the southwesterly line of Lot C as shown on a plan filed in the office of the City Engineer of the City of Newton under number 38076; thence N 31°-47'59" E, 20 feet more to the northeasterly line of said permanent surface to the northeasterly line of said permanent surface (asoment of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; thence N 31°-47'-59" E, 208.45 feet to the southwesterly line of a proposed way; thence S 58°-12'-01" E, 64.34 line of a proposed way; thence S 58°-12'-01" E, 64.34 feet; thence S 66°-53'-10" E, 135.13 feet to the point of beginning; the last two described lines being by said proposed way.

Beginning at a point on the southwesterly line of a proposed way, distant 199.47 feet northwest of the northwesterly line of Williams Street; thence S 31°-47'-59" W, 208.45 feet to the northeasterly line of a permanent surface easement along the Charles River taken by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on January 14, 1958; thence S 31°-47'-59" W, 20 feet more or less to the shore line of the Charles River; thence northwesterly by said shore line of the Charles River to a point on the extension of the southeasterly line of a proposed way; thence N 29°-32'-59" E, 20 feet more or less to the northeasterly line of said surface easement; thence continuing N 29°-32'-59" E, 224.61 feet along the southeasterly line of said proposed way to its intersection with the southwesterly line of the first mentioned proposed way; thence S 58°-12'-01" E, 131.08 feet along said southwesterly line of the first mentioned proposed way to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS: The Board of Aldermen has authorized and received two independent appraisals of the values of all of said parcels as well as a subsequent independent analysis of said appraisals; and

WHEREAS: Said acquisitions are consistent with the City's Capital Improvement Program, the Charles River Pathway Plan of 1975, and the Metropolitan Area Planning Council's Regional Recreation and Open Space Plan;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That Lot 2 be taken in fee together with all rights, title and interest including all the trees thereon and with all rights, title and interest to and over the bed of the Charles River adjacent to said Lot 2 but subject to and with the benefit of all easements of record. The acquisition of Lot 2 is for the municipal purposes of park and recreation uses;

FURTHER ORDERED: That Lots A and C be taken in fee together with all rights, title and interest, including all the trees thereon,

but subject to the MDC casement recorded in the Middlesex South

District Doeds at Book 9146, Page 003, and subject to any easement or

rights of way of record that may exist over the proposed way that abuts

Lots A and C as shown on the plan referred to above. The acquisition

of Lots A and C is for the municipal purposes of park and recreation uses;

FURTHER ORDERED: That upon recommendation of His Honor the Mayor, the following awards are hereby made to the persons, companies, corporations, trustees or other legal entities whose land is being so taken, and the expenditures authorized for such awards under the direction of His Honor the Mayor by the Planning Department for the above takings as follows:

FURTHER ORDERED: That \$5,000 be appropriated into Planning
Department Account No. 1500-C019 for related acquisition costs and
other expenses incurred and to be incurred with reference to the taking
of the above described parcels.

FURTHER ORDERED: (1) That Lot 2 be hereby placed in the sole custody of the Newton Recreation Commission for the administration. control and maintenance in accordance with Chapter 631 of the Acts of 1969 and Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 45, Section 14, and (2) that Lots A and C be hereby placed in the sole custody of the Newton Conservation Commission for the administration, control and maintenance in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40, Section 8C, as amended.

FURTHER ORDERED:

That in accordance with the recommendation of His Henor the Mayor, the sum of Sixty-three thousand dollars (\$63,000) to be taken from Sale of Municipal Property Receipts Reserved, be and is hereby appropriated, granted and expenditure authorized under direction of His Honor the Mayor by the Planning Department for the above taking.

FURTHER ORDERED:

That the City Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to borrow in anticipation of Federal Grants in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 8C, the sum of Two hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (9252,000), to accomplish the above taking.

Bounded on the east by Winchester Street, on the south by land now or formerly of Working Boy's Home, on the west by the Charles River Country Club, Inc. and land of Jeremiah E. and Alice D. Greene.

This transfer is made on condition that the ten acres of the above parcel of land most immediately adjacent to Winchester St., subject to an easement for access to the remainder of said land, be transferred to the School Department for school and school yeard purposes if and when the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Newton request that such a transfer be made after finding that there is a need for the use of said land for school and school yard purposes.




